**REINFORCING THE DESIGNATION OF THE UNITED STATES ARMY CRIMINAL INVESTIGATION COMMAND AS A DIRECT REPORTING UNIT**

1. Effective 16 October 2006, this reinforces sentence one, paragraph 5, of Headquarters, Department of the Army General Orders 2003-09, dated 26 September 2003, designating U.S. Army Criminal Investigation Command (USACIDC) (UIC: W3KPAA) as a direct reporting unit to the Provost Marshal General, Headquarters, Department of the Army, effective 1 October 2004.
2. Mission: USACIDC conducts criminal investigations and provides protective services for designated Department of the Army and Department of Defense officials.
3. Effective 16 October 2006, the provisions of sentence 2 in paragraph 5 of Headquarters, Department of the Army General Orders 2003-09, dated 26 September 2003, are hereby superseded.
