**DESIGNATION OF THE U.S. ARMY MEDICAL COMMAND
AS A DIRECT REPORTING UNIT**

1. Effective 16 October 2006, the U.S. Army Medical Command (MEDCOM) (UIC: W3VYAA) is designated as a Direct Reporting Unit of The Surgeon General of the Army.
2. MEDCOM provides medical, dental, and veterinary capabilities to the Army and designated Department of Defense activities; operates fixed facilities; conducts medical research, development, testing and evaluation; executes medical materiel acquisition programs as assigned by the Army Acquisition Executive; manages Army medical materiel; educates and trains personnel; and develops medical concepts, doctrine, and systems to support Army healthcare delivery.
3. Effective 16 October 2006, the provisions of Headquarters, Department of the Army General Orders No. 20, dated 10 August 1994, inconsistent with this order are hereby superseded.
