II. FORT STORY, HARBOR DEFENSE OF CHESAPEAKE BAY, VIRGINIA.—Effective 1 July 1948, Fort Story, Harbor Defense of Chesapeake Bay, Virginia, a class I installation under control of the Commanding General, Second Army, will be reclassified, including its present subinstallations, a class II subinstallation of Fort Eustis, Virginia, under the control of the Chief of Transportation. The Harbor Defense functions at Fort Story, Virginia, and its subinstallations will remain as a class I activity under control of the Commanding General, Second Army.

III. QUARTERMASTER SUBSISTENCE TESTING LABORATORY, OAKLAND, CALIFORNIA.—Effective 1 July 1948, the Quartermaster Subsistence Testing Laboratory, Oakland Army Base, Oakland, California, a class II activity under the control of The Quartermaster General will be reclassified a class I activity under the control of the Commanding General, Sixth Army.

2. *Effective 2359, 30 June 1948*, the United States Military Academy Preparatory School at Stewart Field, New York, will be designated a class II activity under the control of the Superintendent, United States Military Academy.
