I..FORT BENJAMIN HARRISON, INDIANA.—Effective 1 October 1948, Fort Benjamin Harrison, Indiana, a class I installation under the control of the Commanding General, Second Army, will be transferred from the jurisdiction of the Department of the Army to the Department of the Air Force by joint agreement.

II..GRAY AIR FORCE AUXILIARY FIELD, TACOMA, WASHINGTON.—Gray Air Force Auxiliary Field, Tacoma, Washington, is designated as part of Fort Lewis, Washington, a class I installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, Sixth Army.

III..ROTC UNITS.—1. Effective as of 25 August 1948, a junior division ROTC unit was established at Oak Ridge Military Institute, Oak Ridge, North Carolina, in addition to the senior ROTC unit established at that institution by paragraph 2, section II, General Orders 57, Department of the Army, 1948.

2. Paragraph 3, section I, General Orders 48, Department of the Army, 1948, is rescinded and the following substituted therefor:
