I..ALABAMA ORDNANCE WORKS, CHILDERSBURG, ALABAMA.—Effective 1 February 1954, the post office address of Alabama Ordnance Works, a class II industrial installation under the jurisdiction of the Chief of Ordnance, is changed from Sylacauga, Alabama to Childersbury, Alabama.
