I. U.S. ARMY MAJOR ITEM SUPPLY MANAGEMENT AGENCY. Effective 23 September 1963, the U.S. Army Major Item Supply Management Agency, a class II activity under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, U.S. Army Materiel Command, located at Letterkenny Army Depot, Pennsylvania, is discontinued.

II. U.S. ARMY MAJOR ITEM DATA AGENCY. Effective 23 September 1963, the U.S. Army Major Item Data Agency is established as a class II activity under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, U.S. Army Materiel Command, at Letterkenny Army Depot, Pennsylvania, a class II installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, U.S. Army Materiel Command.

III. ARMY AND AIR FORCE EXCHANGE SERVICE CENTER ATLANTIC SERVICE CENTER. Effective 2400 hours, 23 October 1963, the Atlantic Service Center, 8 West 14th Street, New York City, New York, 10011, is discontinued. All functions and responsibilities previously performed by the Atlantic Service Center are transferred to and will be assumed by the Southern Service Center, 111 Ivy Street, N.E., Atlanta, Georgia, effective 0001 hours, 24 October 1963.

IV. WARRIOR OF THE PACIFIC TEAM COMPETITION. In accordance with paragraph 8, AR 145-395, the annual Warrior of the Pacific rifle competition was conducted at General Military Science ROTC training camps. Seattle University, Seattle, Washington, is announced as the winner of the Warrior of the Pacific trophy for the year 1963. Average score per man was 77.14.
