**I. DEPARTMENT OF THE ARMY AWARDS FOR SAFETY.**

Under the provisions of paragraph 16, AR 385-10, the following organizations are awarded Department of the Army Awards for Safety for fiscal year 1963:

**II. THE UNITED STATES MILITARY MISSION, REPUBLIC OF CONGO, LEOPOLDVILLE, REPUBLIC OF CONGO.** *Effective 26 January 1963*, the United States Military Mission, Republic of Congo, is established with station in Leopoldville, Republic of Congo, under the jurisdiction of the Deputy Chief of Staff for Military Operations, Headquarters, Department of the Army.

**III. ROTC UNITS AT PURDUE UNIVERSITY, LAFAYETTE, INDIANA.** *Effective the beginning of the 1963-64 school year*, the following branch material ROTC units at Purdue University, Lafayette, Indiana, are converted to a General Military Science ROTC unit:

**IV. JUNIOR DIVISION ROTC SUBUNIT, HOKE SMITH HIGH SCHOOL, ATLANTA, GEORGIA.** *Effective 30 August 1963*, the Junior Division ROTC subunit was withdrawn from Hoke Smith High School, Atlanta, Georgia, and transferred to Booker T. Washington High School, Atlanta, Georgia.
