**I. INTELLIGENCE CORPS, U.S. ARMY.** *Effective 1 March 1966*, the position of Chief, Intelligence Corps is abolished and the Intelligence Corps, U.S. Army is discontinued.

**II. UNITED STATES ARMY INTELLIGENCE THREATS AND FORECASTS GROUP.** *Effective 21 January 1966*, the U.S. Army Intelligence Threats and Forecasts Group (USAITFG), is established as a class II activity under the jurisdiction of the Assistant Chief of Staff for Intelligence, Headquarters, Department of the Army, with station at Fort George G. Meade, Md., a class I installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, First U.S. Army.
