**I. GENERAL COURTS-MARTIAL.** The Commanding Officer, United States Army Training Center, Infantry and Fort Ord, is designated by the Secretary of the Army, pursuant to the Uniform Code of Military Justice, Article 22(a) (6), to convene general courts-martial, *effective 22 May 1967.*

**II. ST. LOUIS ARMY TANK-AUTOMOTIVE STEEL FOUNDRY, ST. LOUIS, MISSOURI.** *Effective 17 April 1967,* the St. Louis Army Tank-Automotive Steel Foundry, a class II inactive installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, U.S. Army Materiel Command, is placed in an active status and redesignated the Gateway Army Ammunition Plant.

**III. JUNIOR ROTC UNITS.** 1. *Effective 1 July 1967,* a class HS Junior ROTC unit is established at Carroll High School, Ozark, Alabama, under the provisions of AR 145-10.

2. So much of paragraph 3, DA General Orders 25, 1966, as pertains to the establishment of a Class HS Junior ROTC unit at Kelly Walsh High School, Casper, Wyoming, is rescinded.
