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I. FORT CUSTER, MICH. *Effective 30 June 1968*, Fort Custer, Mich., was discontinued as a Department of the Army installation. The retained portion is designated the Custer Reserve Forces Training Area.

II. FORT HAYES, OHIO. *Effective 1 July 1968*, Fort Hayes, Ohio, a class I inactive installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, First United States Army, is designated a subinstallation of Fort Knox, Ky.
