I. FORT POLK, LOUISIANA. Effective 23 October 1968, Fort Polk, Louisiana, was designated a permanent Department of the Army installation.

II. DEPARTMENT OF THE ARMY LIAISON GROUP FOR ADSAF COMBAT SERVICE SUPPORT SYSTEM (CS3) PROTOTYPE INSTALLATION, FORT HOOD TEXAS. Effective 15 November 1968, the Department of the Army Liaison Group for ADSAF Combat Service Support System (CS3) Prototype Installation (Short Title: DA CS3 Liaison Group), a class II activity under the jurisdiction of the Assistant Chief of Staff for Force Development, Headquarters, Department of the Army, is transferred to the jurisdiction of the Assistant Vice Chief of Staff (MISD), Headquarters, Department of the Army.
