I. US ARMY ALASKA. Effective 1 July 1974, the US Army Alaska is relieved from assignment as a major command to Headquarters, Department of the Army and assigned as a major subordinate command of US Army Forces Command.

II. US ARMY FORCES SOUTHERN COMMAND. Effective 1 July 1974, the US Army Forces Southern Command is relieved from assignment as a major command to Headquarters, Department of the Army and assigned as a major subordinate command of US Army Forces Command.

III. STANLEY R. MICKELSEN SAFEGUARD COMPLEX. Effective 1 October 1974, the SAFEGUARD tactical facilities in North Dakota are designated the Stanley R. Mickelsen Safeguard Complex.
