I. MISSISSIPPI ARMY AMMUNITION PLANT, MISSISSIPPI. *Effective 1 January 1978*, Mississippi Army Ammunition Plant was established as an Army industrial installation under the command jurisdiction of the Commanding General, US Army Materiel Development and Readiness Command.

II. JUNIOR ROTC UNITS. So much of DA General Orders Number 8, 3 May 1978, pertaining to Marcos DeNiza High School, Tempe, Arizona, as reads "With instruction to begin not later than opening school year 1978-1979" is amended to read "With instruction to begin not later than opening school year 1979-1980."
