**History.** This publication is an administrative revision. The portions affected by this administrative revision are listed in the summary of change.

**Summary.** This revision authorizes the rescission of tables 1 through 41. The tables are replaced by the electronic version of Army addresses on the U.S. Army Records Management and Declassification Agency (RMDA) Web page located at <https://www2.arims.army.mil/aao> and on

the Army Electronic Library CD-ROM (EM 0001).

**Applicability.** This DA pamphlet applies to the Active Army, the Army National Guard of the United States (ARNGUS), and the U.S. Army Reserve. This publication is not applicable during mobilization.

**Proponent and exception authority.** The proponent of the DA pamphlet is the Deputy Chief of Staff, G–1. The Deputy Chief of Staff, G–1 has to authority to approve exceptions or waivers to this regulation that are consistent with controlling law and regulations. The Deputy Chief of Staff, G–1 may delegate the approval authority, in writing, to a division chief within the proponent agency or a direct reporting unit or field operating agency of the proponent agency in the grade of colonel or the civilian equivalent. Activities may request a waiver to this regulation by providing justification that includes a full analysis of the expected benefits and must include formal review by the activity's senior legal officer. All waiver requests will be endorsed by the commander or senior leader of the requesting activity

and forwarded through their higher headquarters to the policy proponent. Refer to AR 25–30 for specific guidance.

**Suggested improvements.** Users are invited to send comments and suggested improvements on DA Form 2028 (Recommended Changes to Publications and Blank Forms) directly to U.S. Army Records Management and Declassification Agency, ATTN: AHRC-PDD-RP, 7701 Telegraph Road, Room 102, Alexandria, VA 22315–3860.

**Distribution.** This publication is available in electronic media only and is intended for command levels A, B, C, D, and E for the Active Army, the Army National Guard of the United States, and the U.S. Army Reserve.

## 4. Identification of Army addresses

*a.* Names, titles, abbreviations, office symbols, building names and complete mailing addresses for all Unified Commands, Army MACOMs, installations, activities, and elements are located at <https://www2.arims.army.mil/aa0>. To use the address listing, select a command or an agency from the dropdown list in section A. If you are not sure, select **ALL** to search the entire listing. Enter your search criteria in section B and click on the **SEARCH** button. Click on the **RESTART SEARCH** button if you start over with a new command or agency. Click on **VIEW ALL** to view all addresses for a selected command or agency.

*b.* Army installations and activities within the continental United States (CONUS) and outside the continental United States (OCONUS) are listed alphabetically, including MACOM jurisdiction. The OCONUS listing provides the actual location of the installation, mailing address, and responsible MACOM. It is not intended to be a complete list of all real property holdings of activities that DA controls.

*c.* The United States Defense Attaché offices for all non-electrical communications up to and including Secret are located at <https://www2.arims.army.mil/aa0>.

*d.* Security assistance organizations and similar activities' addresses are located at <https://www2.arims.army.mil/aa0>.
